



Dear Mayor and Commissioners

In view of the fact that the natural wildlife habitat in Broward County is dwindling to an unacceptable point and the fact that golf courses do not lend themselves particularly well to residential development, South Florida Audubon Society is opposed to the conversion of golf courses to residential/commercial development.

Many Tamarac residents are opposed to the move, and rightfully so, as they bought their homes because of their proximity to golf course facilities.

In the strategic plan for the City of Tamarac, it is stated that “The City of Tamarac will utilize innovative management to develop and maintain a strong financial base, while balancing the financial needs of the City with preservation of the environment”.

This move to develop golf courses compromises the preservation of the environment through the loss of green space and wildlife habitat heretofore provided by the golf courses and contravenes the City’s own strategic plan.

South Florida Audubon Society stands with Tamarac residents in asking you to deny land use changes that would facilitate such development.
